1. Working On The Business

Ranchers attending the seminar will learn why working on their businesses is the first step in building a sustainable business.

2. The Three Secrets For Increasing Profit

Starting with no land, no livestock, no money and no time, participants will build a livestock business from scratch. As they put together the business they will see what it takes to earn a healthy profit and why most ranches earn a big loss. They will discover there are only three things (the three "secrets") that any business can do to increase profit.

3. Knowing What The Numbers Mean

Most ranchers don't have a firm grip on their economic and financial situation. Ranchers attending the workshop will learn how to benchmark their businesses to determine which of the three secrets for increasing profit applies to them.

4. Show Me The Money

Most ranchers have >90% of their money tied up in "fixed assets" and very little in working capital. This is why most of us are wealthy on their balance sheet and broke at the bank. Workshop participants will see how many Ranching For Profit School alumni overcame this challenge and created highly profitable businesses.

5. Working With Nature

Most Ranch Businesses are structured to fight nature. The result is economic, financial, environmental and personal stress. Participants will see how their businesses fight natural cycles and will learn how to restructure their operations to be in synch with the environment to increase profit.
